

ALLERGENS

This statement covers the Bagla Group product range.

EU Regulation 1169/2011 on the provision of food information to consumers, which came into force on 13th December 2014, lists 14 substances and products thereof causing allergies or intolerances:

1. Cereals containing gluten, namely: wheat, rye, barley, oats, spelt and kamut or their hybridised strains;
2. Crustaceans;
3. Eggs;
4. Fish;
5. Peanuts;
6. Soy beans;
7. Milk;
8. Nuts, namely: almonds, hazelnuts, walnuts, cashews, pecan nuts, Brazil nuts, pistachio nuts and macadamia or Queensland nuts;
9. Celery;
10. Mustard;
11. Sesame seeds;
12. Sulphur dioxide and sulphites;
13. Lupin;
14. Molluscs.

We can confirm, to the best of our knowledge, that allergens in this list and products thereof are not intentionally added during manufacture of our products. Bagla Group's POF Shrink Films manufacturing facilities operate under BRC accreditation requiring an understanding of the risks of allergen contamination by our suppliers or by poor sanitation at our facilities. Suitable hygiene policies, including hand washing procedures, are in place across all Filtrona sites to prevent cross contamination in production and storage areas. However, we do not specifically test for the presence of any of the listed allergens or products thereof and ubiquitous traces can never be entirely excluded.
